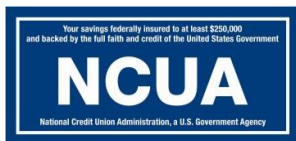

April 17, 2017 is the Deadline for 2016 IRA Contributions

Did you know that you have until the tax filing deadline – April 17th this year – to make a 2016 contribution? Traditional IRA contributions may be fully or partially deductible, depending on your income, filing status, whether you are covered by a retirement plan at work, and whether you receive Social Security benefits.

There is a limit on how much you can contribute to your IRA. Visit www.irs.gov or consult with a tax professional for more information about the advantages of an IRA.
