If you already have a magnetic strip debit card from Trans Texas, you will be receiving a new EMV Chip enabled debit card through the mail. Please activate your new chip card as soon as you receive it to start enjoying its enhanced security features!

One of the best security features is the FREEZE/UNFREEZE button available through online banking and our mobile app.

Once you have signed up for home banking through transtexas.coop, you can download our Trans Texas mobile app for the easiest access to your accounts! Inside the mobile app, you can freeze your debit card at the push of a button. To use your card, simply tap that same button, giving you control of when and where your card can be used. This convenience offers you peace of mind while at home or away!

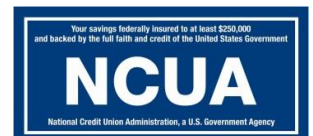
